Tips

- ❖ Start stitching the design in the center of the fabric and work outwards towards the edges. Arrows on the charts indicate the position of the center point.
- ❖ Each square of the chart represents a stitch.

- ❖ The color key shows the range of colors required and gives DMC thread color codes.
- ❖ Threads come in 6 stands. These should be divided into 3 sections of 2 stands to work with.

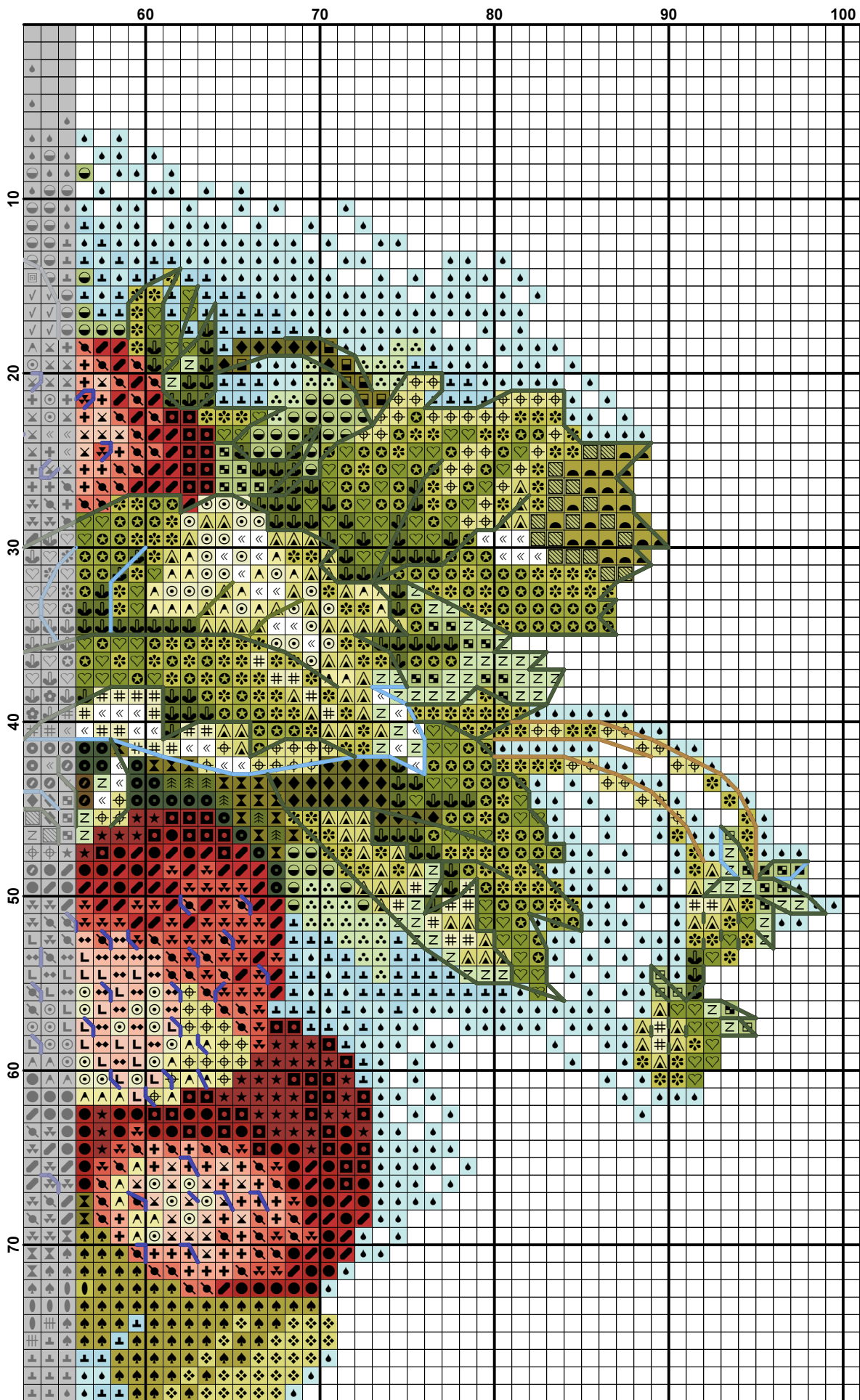


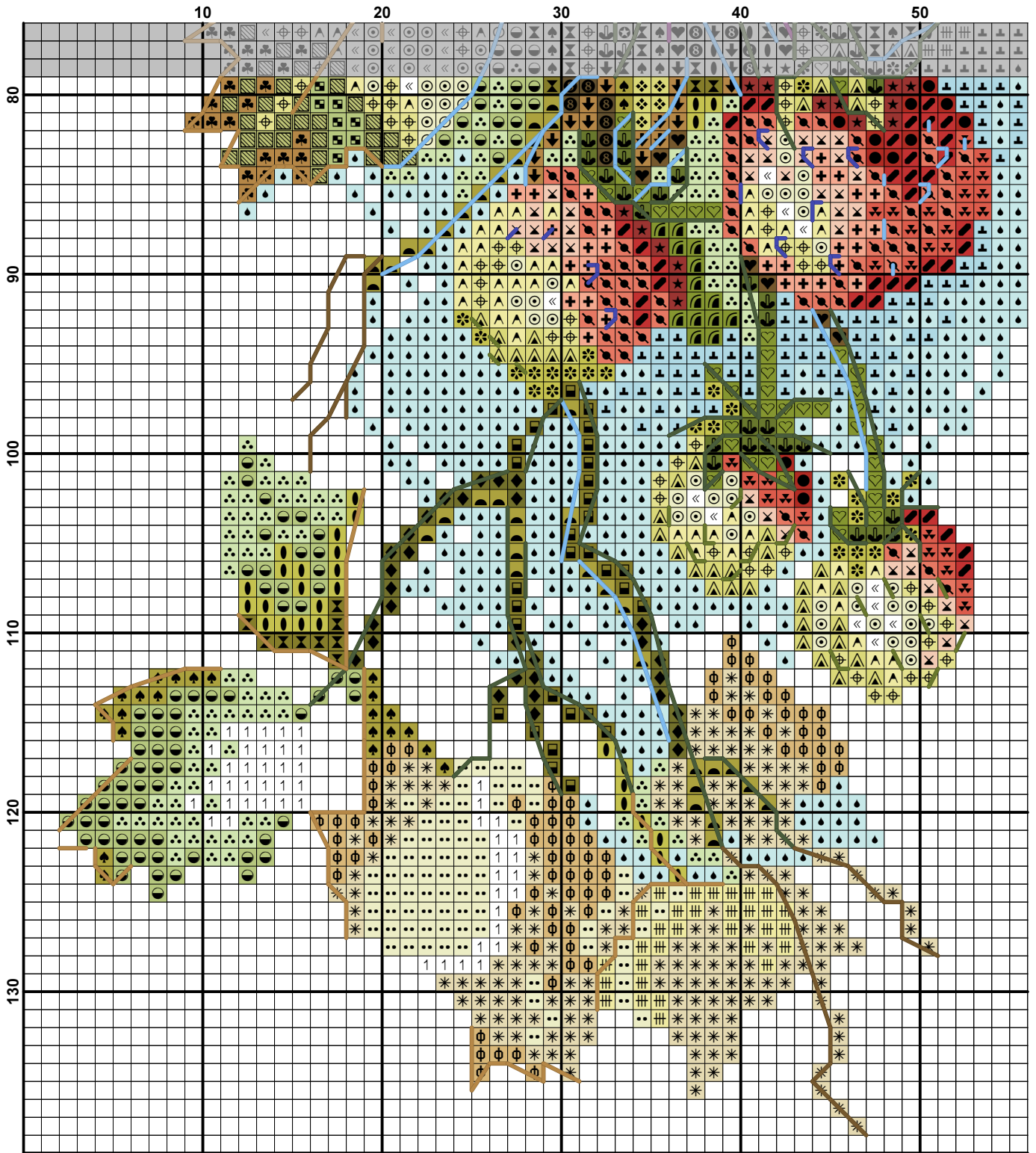


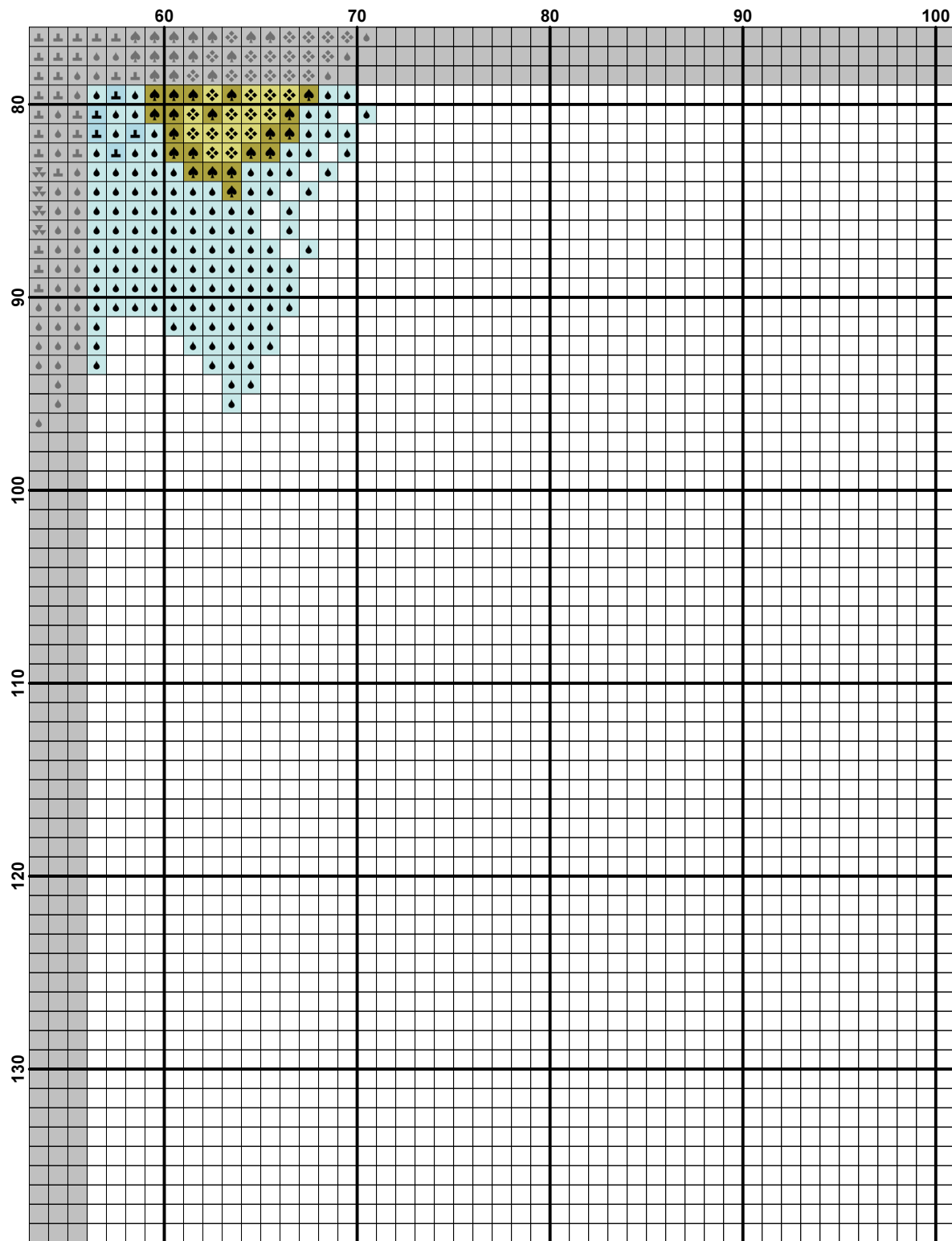














Stitching instructions

	Symbol	How to stitch	Details
Cross Stitch			It is easier and quicker to work rows of full stitches. Work across the fabric from bottom left to upper right corners, and then back to complete the row of full crosses. Always make sure your X's slant in the same direction. For 14-18 count, use 2 strands of thread. For 11 count, use 3-4 strands of thread.
Blend			Blended threads are used to add tonality to the image. Take 1 strand of each thread (check the key). Next, thread your needle with 2 differently coloured strands and stitch
Back Stitch			Back Stitch is a row of straight stitches, made with the number of strand (check the key). Select a short, sharp, small-eyed needle for back stitch. Insert the needle at the end of the previous stitch.
French Knot			Bring the needle up from the back to the front where your first knot is indicated. Holding the floss firmly in your left hand and the needle in your right, wrap the floss around the needle 2 times. Hold the needle in your right hand. With your left, gently pull the floss until the twists tighten around the needle. As you do, the wraps will naturally begin sliding down toward the tip of the needle. Place the point of the needle into the fabric very close to where the floss originally exited the fabric. Using your thumb on top of the fabric, and your forefinger on the back, grasp the fabric. Use the tip of your thumb or thumbnail to hold the twists in place. With your right hand, pull the needle and floss through to the back of the fabric. This locks the knot in place.
